# ANNUAL REPORT ON THE DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES 2018-2019






The talk concluded with a discussion where the participants and the speaker exchanged ideas on the enduring appeal of Shakespearean theatre and its relevance in today's world. The students had the

The programme concluded with the Vote of Thanks delivered by Maya N Menon, Assistant Professor, Department of English.


**Invited Talk II:**





# Invited Talk: "THE ART OF CRAFTING MICROFICTION" Date: 8th November 2019 Time: 1:30 pm - 3:30 pm



Release of Manuscript Magazine "BOHEMIAN VOICES"






### Date: 14th February 2020 Time: 1:30 pm - 3:30 pm

# ANNUAL REPORT ON THE DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES 2020-2021

In 2020, educational institutions worldwide faced significant disruptions due to the COVID-19 pandemic, leading to a shift in activities and the mode of academic engagements. The specific measures adopted by the Department of English to cater to the needs of students for providing them with quality education depended on the use of the available technological infrastructure which included engaging classes via GoogleMeet and assessing their progression through Google Classrooms. Asynchronous learning was adopted where students could access pre-recorded lectures anytime anywhere at the comfort of their homes. This approach provided flexibility for students who faced various challenges during the pandemic. Digital Learning Resources: Educational materials, textbooks, and supplementary resources were made available electronically to support Google classrooms and other digital educational modes such as Moodle etc. The traditional mode of conducting examination and evaluation were replaced with online assessments, including open-book exams, essays, projects, and quizzes administered through learning management systems. The Department made efforts to maintain student engagement through virtual clubs, activities, and events. Academic and mental health support services were offered remotely, including virtual counselling, tutoring, and academic advising. Those students who failed to have steady internet accessibility or suitable environment for online classes were provided resources through hard copies. The pandemic prompted educators to explore new teaching methods, variant technological tools and online resources, leading to pedagogical innovations that continue beyond the pandemic.

Many activities conducted before the pandemic were being shifted to the online mode to ensure the safety of students and staff. Transformative initiatives such as literary seminars, creative writing workshops, induction, and bridge courses etc conducted in college were forced to go into online mode. Though the challenges put forth by the pandemic at the very outset were unprecedented and daunting, they also presented an opportunity for the Department to innovate, adapt, and demonstrate an unwavering commitment to our students' well-being and educational growth in all possible ways. The programmes conducted by the Department of English of NSS College, Nemmara during the academic year 2020-21 are as follows.

### QUESTA 2020 Date:15 June 2020



# National webinar on MOOCs – Massive Open online Course organized on 9<sup>th</sup> of June 2021






# ADD-ON COURSE COMMUNICATION AND SOFT SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING




### **EXTENSION PROGRAMME 2021-22**





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




### English Language Certificate Program on "Language Acquisition and Skill Enhancement"-Report on Add on course
